CAMP SESSIONS

Section A: Explorers Camp is for ages 2.5-3 and is offered during morning session. Campers are not required to be toilet trained.

Section B: Voyagers Camp is for ages 4-10 and is offered during morning session. Campers must be toilet trained and independent in the bathroom.

Section C: Rangers Camp is for ages 4-10 and is offered during afternoon session. Campers must be toilet trained and independent in the bathroom.

Section D: Adventurers Camp is for ages 4-10 and is offered on Fridays only as a field trip to offsite locations within a 15-mile radius of the school. Parents must drop off and pick up campers on site. Each week campers will explore a local park, forest, wetland, beach or farm to experience hands-on learning about each location's unique diversity of plants, animals and ecosystems. Campers must be toilet trained and independent in the bathroom.

Section E: Trailblazers Camp is for ages 6-10 and is held entirely outdoor. Campers must be toilet trained and independent in the bathroom.
